A few studies have shown that if you listen to a musical phrase several times in a row, you are subconsciously learning that phrase by recognizing new details each time. In contrast, if you read aloud the phrase aloud, you are only learning the basic letter patterns and are not paying close attention to the nuances of the written musical score, which are the information the brain needs to learn to recognize and produce sounds. It has also been known that when people hear a foreign language, they will learn the new language better if they keep listening to the new language, as opposed to reading about it, or simply studying the language. Practice makes perfect when it comes to learning a new language, and if you are lucky enough to learn a language that has a wide vocabulary, the more you study, the more vocabulary you will be learning.

History In the 1990s, Roland Barthes theorized that music functions as a language for babies to learn. The most recently discovered theory was proposed by an Indian musicologist T. Shrinivasan in his publication *Sounding Surreal: Aesthetic, Mind and the Aesthetics of Music*. Barthes uses the concept of musico-logical imagery to describe how music works for babies. Barthes writes that the time and space of sound that is when it is heard for the first time allows you to hear music and comprehend that it is a non-representational language. Furthermore, the music that is played provides the baby with clues as to how to interpret this language.
